

The National Railway Historical Society was founded in 1935 and incorporated as a nonprofit, educational organization in Maryland in 1937. The Society has two primary purposes: to support and provide education on the history of railroad transportation; and to preserve historical material and information pertaining to railroad transportation. Toward these ends, the Society conducts a variety of programs at both the National and local Chapter levels.

The Society has more than 13,000 members and over 160 Chapters. The Society publishes a quarterly journal, *The National Railway Bulletin*, containing articles of historical, educational, and topical subjects of railroad interest.

Membership is open to all persons who are interested in railroads and their history. The major classes of membership are:

#### **Regular (Chapter) Membership**

Members affiliated with a local Chapter of the National Railway Historical Society, in addition to the National organization.

#### **At-Large (Independent) Membership**

Members of the National Railway Historical Society who do not wish to affiliate with a local NRHS Chapter. Persons under the age of 18 years, applying for this class of membership only, must have the written approval for such application by a parent or legal guardian. While we strongly encourage you to join through the Chapter distributing this form, anyone interested in this class of Membership should contact our National Headquarters, listed on the back of the Application.

#### **Student Membership**

A discounted annual membership available for individuals 13 to 24 years of age (on January 1). A parent or legal guardian's signature is required for this category.

#### **Youth Membership**

A discounted annual membership available for individuals 5 to 12 years of age (on January 1). A parent or legal guardian's signature is required for this category.

#### **Family Membership**

An optional Family Membership is available for a family member who resides in the same household as the member.
